Group's efforts backed

An mp is backing a community groups search for funding for their work in communities blighted by substance abuse.

Since 2002, the West Glamorgan Council for Alcohol and Drug Abuse (WGCADA) has provided vital outreach services in the Bridgend county area.

These services were funded by the recovered assets fund, which takes money from convicted criminals.

But Ogmore MP Huw Irranca-Davies said this scheme has now been wound up. 'The assembly funds drug treatment in Wales and I hope they will be able to offer support and advice so that the WGCADA can keep its important work.'
